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

WHAT DO YOUR STUDENTS KNOW NOW?

Prior to exploring PAPER PLANET with your students, find out how much they already know about **paper and its properties**. In addition, allow them to explore the themes of planets, creating a world and theater.

What art can you create with a sheet of paper? What are the different things you can do?

What would your ideal world look like? What kinds of creatures would live in this world? What buildings would make up this world?

What do you think of when you hear the word "theater"? Does theater need to look a certain way? Be performed in a certain place or by certain people?

IMMERSIVE THEATER is any type of theater that invites the audience to actively participate in the performance. There is no "fourth wall" and the actors interact directly with audience members. The audience plays an important role in immersive theater. They essentially have a part in building the dramatic world and can control the plot, the characters and, in the case of PAPER PLANET, the set!

An **INTERACTIVE INSTALLATION** is a large work of art that requires audience interaction. The audience's participation can actually create the installation or change its entire meaning. These installations can be made out of movable materials but can also be created using the internet or even your cell phone! It is up to the audience, rather than the artist, to create the art's meaning. In PAPER PLANET, it is up to you, the audience, to create your own meaningful work of art out of movable materials!
